### **BKC'S CODE OF ETHICS**

This code is established in accordance with the objectives of the Bismarck Kennel Club (BKC) and is set forth to protect and advance the interests of all dogs by encouraging sportsmanlike competition at dog shows, field trials, obedience trials, tracking tests, and other dog sports. Club members shall always conduct themselves in a manner that will reflect credit upon themselves, their dogs (regardless of the genetic makeup of the dogs), and the sport of dogs, regardless of the location or circumstances. Additionally, this code of ethics has been devised to protect and advance the interests of dog breed preservation, by maintaining high breeding standards for AKC recognized and AKC registered Purebred dogs.

### **HEALTH OF DOGS**

The owner shall maintain the best possible standards of canine health, cleanliness, and veterinary care, including mental health such as contact with people and exposure to the outside world.

#### REGISTRATION OF DOGS

In order to compete in the sport of dogs, all dogs (regardless of their genetic composition and makeup) will be registered with the AKC in the appropriate category. For dogs not already listed and registered as an AKC purebred, options include the Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) for purebred dogs <u>not</u> listed or able to be listed as an AKC-recognized purebred. Alternatively, Mixed-breed dogs are to be registered through the AKC's Canine Partners Program. Members agree to follow the guidelines of those registrations, namely, "...THAT THIS DOG HAS BEEN SPAYED/NEUTERED OR THAT IT, BEING A PUPPY, WILL BE SPAYED/NEUTERED AT SUCH TIME AS RECOMMENDED BY MY VETERINARIAN AND THAT I (WE) WILL SUBMIT WRITTEN VERIFICATION IF REQUESTED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB." In the case of Mixed Breed, Canine Partner registrations, the owners will also agree and "...CERTIFY THAT THIS DOG IS NOT A WOLF OR THE IMMEDIATE PROGENY OF A WOLF/CANINE CROSSBREEDING." No Member shall breed or attempt to breed a dog registered as a PAL or Canine Partner.

# BREEDING OF AKC-RECOGNIZED AND AKC-REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDS

# The breeder shall:

- 1. Follow the Breed Parent Club health testing requirements prior to breeding any stud or bitch.
- 2. Breed only with the intention of improving the breed, and finding suitable homes for the puppies
- 3. Choose only healthy parents of good temperament and qualities in relation to the AKC-approved Official Breed Standards, and who have been deemed genetically sound by testing as recommended by the parent club of your breed or breeds.
- 4. Breed only mature bitches with excellent prenatal care for the dam and puppies.
- 5. Refuse to breed a stud to any bitch who is inferior physically, mentally, or temperamentally.
- 6. It is the breeder's responsibility to take back or re-home any dog they have produced for the life of that dog. Breeder contracts are to be used.
- 7. The owner shall breed only AKC-registered or AKC-recognized foreign registered dogs with other AKC-registered or AKC-recognized foreign dogs, and keep accurate records of matings and pedigrees.

#### SALES OF AKC-RECOGNIZED AND AKC-REGISTERED PUREBRED BREEDS

- 1. Not to auction, raffle, sell, or consign puppies or adults to pet shops or other commercial dealers.
- 2. Use limited registration or spay/neuter contracts for all pet puppies sold that will not be used for competition in AKC events
- 3. Honestly evaluate the quality of the dog or puppy sold and fairly represent that evaluation.
- 4. Not release puppies before they are at least eight weeks of age and furnish details on feedings, general care, medical inoculations, veterinary care, pedigrees, etcetera.
- 5. Screen all prospective buyers to ensure that the puppies will have safe and loving homes.
- 6. Follow up on puppies after the sale to ensure their continuing care and to encourage the owners to become involved in activities of show, obedience, rally, agility, hunting, and tracking.
